



2011 City on the Hill What to Bring

Clothing: Please keep in mind that this is a conservative, Christian conference. We want to present an appropriate image of who we are and who we represent. We will be meeting professional business, political and media people, and we will visit the state capitol twice.

What you should bring: Change of clothing for six days and five nights.

What's appropriate: Jeans, shorts, skirts, T-shirts, tennis shoes, sandals, jacket or sweater.
Business attire (coats and ties for guys, dresses/skirts or nice business suits for girls) **is required for visits to the capitol (Thursday and Saturday), and for the Saturday evening banquet.**

What's not appropriate: Tank tops, strapless shirts, mini-skirts or short-shorts, bra straps showing, belly-buttons showing, boxers showing, bare feet, and tight shorts, pants, or tops. *"Modesty results from the purity of mind, or from the fear of disgrace and ignominy (i.e., public disgrace; shame; dishonor) fortified by education and principle."* – Noah Webster, 1828 Dictionary

Cash: The cost for planned activities is covered in the conference tuition. However, students should bring some spending money for making phone calls, purchasing souvenirs, snacks and sodas, etc.

Toiletries: Soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, brush, comb, shampoo, deodorant, etc.

Linens: Sheets, blankets, pillows and towels will **NOT** be provided by the campus dorms. Please bring your own. Remember to clearly mark your name on all your items.

Miscellaneous: Alarm clocks are a must! Cell phones are not permitted in dorm rooms overnight so bring another type of alarm clock. Bible, notebook, pens or pencils for note-taking, back-pack or book bag for carrying materials, flashlight, hairdryer, camera, watch, etc.

Talent Show: There will be a talent show on Friday night. Plan to participate and bring anything you will need to perform. This is always a popular event, so come prepared!

What Not to Bring: Do not bring electronic or stereo equipment such as radios, iPods, TVs, laptop computers, printers, palm pilots, etc. These items can be a distraction and if any are discovered, they will be confiscated and returned at the end of the conference.

Note: Although cell phone use will be permitted during specified times, we suggest you leave them at home. They will be confiscated if used at inappropriate times.
